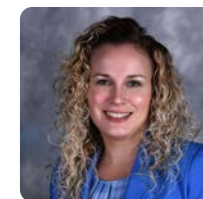
JASON VASARIS

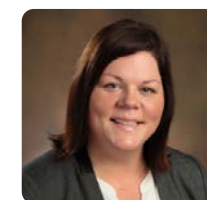

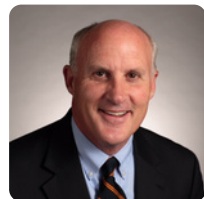
